



Asset Inventory Volunteers:

The Nebraska Lewis & Clark Commission wishes to thank you for contributing your time, dedication and persistence to the first phase of this very important project. We are excited to take the next steps and hope you share this feeling. Some of us actually expect this to be a lot of fun! However, we are also certainly aware that the commitment of your valuable time and effort are quite serious.

Here are some key concepts concerning our next phase. As always, we appreciate your feedback. This will help as we work to make this a comprehensive project for the legacy of our stretch of the Trail, but also for to refine this process for future similar efforts.

Timeline:

April 1 through 15: Inventory a couple of assets that are close to you out in the field and then come back, and enter them into the online system. Then let's see how these initial submissions look as a group on the web site, and then discuss via email.

April 15 through June 15: Try to wind up the inventory. As submissions are made and reviewed by the data manager (me), they will be posted for public view. We will then have "a panel of experts" review, as well as put out some press to get widespread public review, to see if anything was missed.

Boundaries:

Even though we have made boundaries to avoid duplication of place-based assets (see table below), we encourage you to disregard boundaries for ephemeral assets that you know about. Members of MOP or the Commission will be encouraged to submit ephemeral assets. We will try to post ephemeral assets as soon as possible so that we might avoid as much duplication as possible, yet still strive to be comprehensive and complete.
